Travel Insurance Plan

Protect your trip with travel insurance

A hunting excursion can be exciting, memorable, but sometimes unpredictable. That's why it makes sense to protect your next trip with travel insurance.

LUO HIGHLY recommends that you protect yourself with travel insurance policies providing for medical evacuation and for lost/stolen baggage, and trip cancellations.

Insuring your baggage, firearms, and personal belongings is very important. No matter how well planned the hunt is, baggage is stolen or lost every year. An insurance premium is a small price to pay for protecting your valuable property.

Medical Evacuation for Hunters Hunting can be dangerous, and often takes place in remote environments. It's nice to have the peace of mind that if something does happen to you on a hunt, you are able to be evacuated to a hospital of your choice.

Cancellation for medical emergency before your hunt starts. You will be covered for any payment made for your hunt if you have to cancel for a family or business partner medical emergency or death

If you are booking one of our back country hunts we highly recommend insurance.

There is another insurance that is just for medical evacuation that we recommend if you wish to decline full coverage and that is Life Flight. Coverage medical evacuation by helicopter to the nearest hospital for immediate medical attention, The cost of this insurance is minimal and is a yearly membership for the entire immediate family. Cost is \$65.00 a year and covers our entire hunting areas. You can go do www.lifeflight.org to sign up for this coverage.

Sleeping bags for Twenty Mile Camp and Pitnear Camp

Spring and Fall bear hunts and Winter Cat hunts done out of either lodge you will have access to laundry facilities.

We recommend high quality outer wear. Nothing is more dissatisfying, then to have a hunt go bad because you have tried to save on the cost of your clothing. We know how much big game hunting means to you. Believe me when I say we have been there, done that and won't do it again. Please make sure to have the clothing needed. **All articles should be packed in duffel type bags. No hard side suitcases or bag with wheels will be packed into camp.**

Please weigh your bags before departing your home. **No more than 75 lb. of gear will be taken into camp per hunter.**

Overnight lodging before your trip starts. It is recommended to come into Grangeville the night before your pack in dates. Here are some suggestions for you for lodging and dining the night before. We will be in touch with you when you arrive into Grangeville and advise you time to meet at the trail head and directions.

Whitebird Summit lodge – bed and breakfast owned and operated by Frank and Terri Schmitz. Terri offers our hunters a special rate of \$115.00 a night and includes dinner and Breakfast. Terri and Frank use to own LockKey U outfitters – so there will be many hunting stories about the area. The guides will also meet you at the lodge the morning you pack in.
